#### How it works...

**Debit Card** 

A customer has the choice of using a debit card on a ThurayaPayphone. These cards of certain value purchased in advance provide the method of making calls on the ThurayaPayphones. The chip cards come in three different denominations namely 10, 15 and 25 Units. They are available with Thuraya Service Providers.

#### "Call For All"

For people who wish to maintain independent billing from the Payphone account can use "Call For All" cards on ThurayaPayphones for their communication needs. "Call For All" allows the caller to communicate without leaving a balance on the ThurayaPayphone SIM account.

## Operating Concept Using "Call For All"








